Guy Robertson joined the practice in 1986 after graduating with double honours from Guy's Hospital London. He subsequently completed three years postgraduate clinical training in Fixed Prosthodontics and Periodontology at the University of Illinois in Chicago.

He taught postgraduate students on the Master's degree in conservative dentistry at the Institute of Dental Surgery, Eastman Dental Hospital London for twelve years and has given lectures in Europe and the United States. He is currently a visiting lecturer at The Royal London Dental Hospital.

He completed a Doctorate (PhD) in 1995. Dr Robertson is recognised by the General Dental Council as a Specialist in Restorative Dentistry and has been doing implant dentistry in the practice since 1990. He also has more than 30 years of experience doing complex crown and bridgework.

He has been President of The American Dental Society of London and has served on the executive committee of The American Dental Society of Europe.

In his spare time Guy is an enthusiastic amateur guitar player and painter.

Graham Bailey joined the practice in 1991. He qualified from the Royal London Hospital and spent three years working as an Oral Surgeon in various hospitals before taking up an appointment in Singapore working with two plastic surgeons on complex facial reconstruction.

Returning to London he completed a Master's degree in Endodontics at the Institute of Dental Surgery, Eastman Dental Hospital London, where he is an Hon. Senior Lecturer and has taught postgraduate students on the specialist programme since 1994. He was also an examiner for the Specialist Training Exam in Endodontology.

He lectures all over the world and has published a number of research articles in the scientific press. He is a referee for the International Endodontic Journal.

He is a past President of the Dental Society of London, has been a member of the British Endodontic Society Council and was a founder member of a European specialist study society [The Langham Endodontic Study Group] which he Chaired in 2001.

He is recognised by the General Dental Council as a Specialist in Endodontics.

Jack Mirza joined the practice in 2006. He was educated in Vienna and graduated from Manchester Dental School in 2000 with multiple honours and the Claudius Ash prize in Restorative dentistry.

After working in general dental practice, he spent 3 years refining his surgical and dental implant skills in Maxillofacial surgery at the Bristol Royal Infirmary, University College London and Great Ormond Street Hospital. During this time, he was awarded the Membership of the Faculty of Dental Surgery, Royal College of Surgeons of England.

In 2004, he embarked on a full-time 3-year specialist training in Prosthodontics at the Eastman Dental Institute, which included a Masters degree in Clinical Dentistry obtained with distinction.

In 2007 he received the Membership in Restorative Dentistry from the Royal College of Surgeons of England.

He is recognised by the General Dental Council as a Specialist in Prosthodontics. Jack has been placing implants for 15 years and has significant experience in complex implant dentistry.

He lectures nationally and was an examiner for the Royal College of Surgeons of England, and is the current President of the London Dental Study Club.

Jack has 3 young children and enjoys general family dentistry as well as specialist work restoring teeth.

Duncan Edworthy joined the practice in October 2010. He was educated in the West Country of England and graduated as a dentist from the University of Birmingham [UK] in 2004.

After working in the field of hospital Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery and in general practice he completed the membership examinations for the Royal College of Surgeons of England in 2006.

In 2007 he began the four-year specialist training pathway in Prosthodontics at the Eastman Dental Institute, University College London. During this time he obtained a Masters in Clinical Dentistry from University College London and in 2011 he completed the examinations for Membership in Prosthodontics at the Royal College of Surgeons in Edinburgh.

Duncan provides general dental care for his patients but his specialist areas of interest include the surgical placement and prosthetic restoration of dental implants, crown and bridgework, aesthetic dentistry and multidisciplinary cases. He enjoys making dental treatment a pleasant experience, especially for nervous patients, both with and without the use of anaesthetist assisted sedation techniques.

Duncan is the Honorary Dental Consultant for the Royal Society of Musicians of Great Britain and regularly works with and provides treatment for professional musicians. Outside of dentistry he enjoys playing the trombone, cooking and travelling.

Dr Ryan specialises in all aspects of child, adolescent, and adult orthodontic treatment, including interceptive early treatment, growth modification, fixed and removable appliances, orthognathic treatment, and aesthetic treatment.

ROUTINE DENTAL CARE

Each of us has undertaken additional postgraduate training in a variety of dental fields and are recognised as Specialists by the General Dental Council. This allows us to care for all of our patients individually using a multidisciplinary approach to the highest standard. We also have a commitment to evaluating advances in dental technology.

HYGIENE

We firmly believe in the principle that prevention is better than cure and provide the best advice to prevent problems developing in the first place. Our hygiene service is the cornerstone of our preventive programme as gum disease causes bad breath, bleeding and in the long term – tooth loss, which is why good oral hygiene is the most effective way to help maintain a healthy mouth.

IMPLANTS

The modern approach to replacing missing teeth, precluding the need for removable dentures. Titanium implants are used to support restorations and can be used to support a number of dental prostheses, including crowns, implant-supported bridges or dentures.

CROWNS & BRIDGES

We provide the full range of crown and bridgework, including the use of dental implants. These techniques allow for the restoration or replacement of individual teeth or may form the basis of a complete oral reconstruction. More complex restorative care is provided by some of the most highly regarded specialists in their field. To achieve these high clinical standards, excellent technical support is essential. We work with some of the very best dental technicians in London with particular expertise in either gold or aesthetic ceramic work.

COSMETIC DENTISTRY

All dentistry has cosmetic implications but in addition to conventional crown and bridge and implant treatment we also offer teeth whitening, veneers and cosmetic fillings.

TEETH WHITENING

A simple and safe way to brighten and lighten your teeth, there is an 'in surgery' or 'at home' option for this treatment.

VENEERS

Both porcelain and composite veneers or facings can be used to improve the appearance of front teeth with minimal preparation of the original teeth

COSMETIC FILLINGS

Tooth coloured fillings have a vastly superior appearance when compared with traditional amalgam fillings.

PERIODONTICS

Treatment of gum conditions is important to help maintain a healthy mouth, fresh breath and to prevent loss of the supporting structures of teeth.

ENDODONTICS

Modern root canal treatment involves a microscopic approach to evaluating root canal anatomy. This allows effective cleaning of the root canal system which completely eradicates the pain associated with an infected tooth.

ORTHODONTICS

Orthodontics involves the realignment of teeth using braces which are usually fixed to the teeth. We work with orthodontists who have a reputation for child as well as adult orthodontics. There is now a range of 'invisible' techniques which may make treatment more acceptable to adults.

REMOVABLE PROSTHODONTICS

Missing teeth can be replaced by a removable denture made from a variety of different materials.
